Our Behaviour Blueprint

Our Behaviour Blueprint is underpinned by the principles of:

Visible Positive Consistency, Visible Kindness

We create:

A Culture of Certainty

Our three expectations are:

Be Ready, Be Caring, Be Safe

Our three visible consistencies are:

Marvellous Manners, Wonderful Walking, Lovely Lining Up

- We consistently reward children for going over and above and for effort
- We give first attention to children who are doing the right thing
- We consistently show kindness and care to all of our children through daily acts of care and positive recognition for **all** children
- We consistently use our Behaviour Rainbow to show recognition of positive choices, effort and going over and above. Pupils are moved up the rainbow in response to positive actions and 'clipped off' when they reach Outstanding
- We use the following positive consequences consistently:
 - Verbal praise
 - Move peg up
 - Clip off
 - Golden peg
 - Values awards – each class chooses a star each week.
 - Values linked Dojo awards (certificates and badges at different milestones)
 - Class Dojo messages sent to individual families sharing their child's positive 'Over and Above' achievement.
 - 'Yes I Can' and 'Courageous Advocacy' badges are awarded recognising qualities of perseverance, resilience, determination and courageous advocacy,
- We use the following consequences with immediacy and consistency
 - a non-verbal reminder – e.g. a look
 - a verbal warning and reminder of behaviour expectations
 - a conversation about the behaviour
 - a consequence
- We have restorative conversations to ensure each child learns from their experience
